### **NEGOTIATING AND BARGAINING**

With the current Collective Agreements set to expire with both universities in the spring, the Negotiation Committees have been meeting regularly at each campus.

The AESES-UM Negotiation Committee finished reviewing the proposals suggested by members during their submission period. Since then a Bargaining Team has been struck, consisting of seven members and two alternates. They are:

The next phase will consist of a membership meeting, where members in attendance will have the opportunity to vote on and approve the list of proposals being presented for bargaining with the UManitoba. This date will be announced in the next few weeks. We will keep you posted once selected. In the meantime, our UWinnipeg members were asked to participate in filling out a survey related to conditions at their workplace in the quest to narrow down the issues to take forth during the upcoming Negotiation and Bargaining Process. Thank you to all those who took the time to share their opinions and feedback. The AESES-UW Negotiation Committee is now in the process of reviewing these proposals and preparing them for their Bargaining Team, which will be struck shortly. A membership meeting for UWinnipeg members will also be announced. Stay tuned to our website for further details.
